Intro 5 mins	In this session today we will: 1. Review progress and address any issues 2. Watch the Stage Manager from The Lion King stage production in London talk about the Circle of Life project. 3. Make sure all structures are in place so that the Circle of Life projects can be delivered. Review aims and achievements so far using the 'Circle of Life' criteria to identify what has been accomplished so far. So much energy has produced a wealth of ideas but this session should crystallise and provide a clear plan to ensure everyone knows what is expected of them. Teaching focus followed by Activity	roles and timeline to enable a successful project. The Circle of Life Planning Structure - if the whole group is working on one project then nominate a writer to write up as you lead the whole class. Deliver this at pace. Encourage the students to complete the sheet and then move on with the tasks they have planned. Students may want to photograph the sheets as evidence. Today there is one major task – to complete Circle of Life Planning Structure. Though you may feel you have urgent tasks that you want to get on with it's important that you complete this sheet. The crucial part will be the discussions that you will have as they will highlight any omissions that you have made: Describe the project This should be the line that they have written describing their project. Challenge the group if it does not do the job. Naming the project This should be specific to their project and may reflect the locality. Timeline and key tasks Emphasise the need to allow more time than they think in getting responses from people about what they want to do. Encourage them to prioritise the order that the tasks should be done in. The discussion may be more important than the outcome. Role allocation Refer back to the Team Leadership Activity and check all are happy and talk through possible strategies to deal with any team problems.	
	They will need to plan for review points as the sessions progress. These should be added to their timeline and adhered to. Consider what	



the impact will be and how the team will know that the project has gone well.

Teaching focus followed by Activity	All members of the group should have a copy. If there is time left over they should work on their project tasks.	
Focus 5 mins	This is now a student-led social action project! Talk about how you feel as you are handing over the responsibility to the team(s) and now will be acting as consultant, facilitator and monitor.
